Through the noble efforts of Dr. T.S. Soundram, affectionately called 'Amma', Gandhigram was founded with the blessings of Mahatma Gandhi for organizing the constructive programmes in Tamil Nadu. It was officially inaugurated on 7th October 1947 by Shri. B.G. Kher, the then Chief Minister of the Composite Bombay State.

At present Gandhigram has grown into a cluster of institutions providing opportunities for general education, training of rural teachers and workers, rehabilitation of women and children, medical and health service and propagation of Khadi and Rural Industries. Located in an enchanting valley flanked by the Sirumalais and the lower Palanis, the place enjoys a salubrious climate with a stimulation for learning, research and service to the rural people.

The Kasturba Hospital meets the health and medical needs of the inmates of Gandhigram and the people of the village around. The Gandhigram Rural Institute, now a Deemed University, is experimenting with new ideas in extending higher education of rural youth. The Institute of Rural Health and Family Welfare Trust serves as a model in developing research, extension and training services in rural health and is considered unique in South-East Asia.

The Lakshmi College of Education named after Smt. Lakshmi Ammal, mother of **Dr. T.S. Soundram**, is an Institute offering programmes in Teacher Education leading to

the award of the B.Ed., M.Phil., and Ph.D. degrees of the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University. Now the College comes under Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University Chennai, from July 1st 2008 onwards. The Lakshmi College of Education was started in 1967 to meet the special requirements of Secondary Schools in rural areas emphasizing the training of graduates in Mathematics, English, Physical science and Biological Science and Home Science to enable them to work in rural high schools and higher secondary schools.

The College is co-educational and the approved annual intake of the College is 50. Students are admitted in the B.Ed., course through counselling (Single window system) conducted by the Government of Tamil Nadu. (Reg. No. 25600/Q2/2007 dt. 6.07.2007) from 2015. According to the new norms of NCTE (2014) the duration of the B.Ed course is two years.

An experimental school, "Soundram Vidhyalaya" named after Dr. T.S. Soundram, was started by the College on 27th June 1985 with a view to introducing innovative curriculum for free expression of children's talents. The faculty members of the college take active part in experimenting new teaching techniques and teaching aids.

EXAMINATIONS

Each candidate whose admission is approved by Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University should apply for the written examination and practical examinations in the first appearance itself. Candidates who have failed to satisfy the minimum attendance norms of Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University will not be permitted to appear for the written examination. Such candidates appearance in the practical examination will stand cancelled automatically.

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

The candidates admitted into the B.Ed degree course in the Colleges of Education affiliated to Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University should select the medium of instruction either as English or as Tamil (as per the availability of medium of instruction in the colleges of education). After the last date of admission, Principals of the Colleges of Education should submit the name list along with the medium of instruction chosen by each candidate to Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University.

In case, if the admitted candidates prefer to change their medium of instruction at later stage of the course it should be permitted only after obtaining necessary written permission from the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, prior to the publication of Nominal Roll.

Medium of instruction chosen by the candidate to pursue the B.Ed. degree course will be indicated in the B.Ed degree course transfer certificate alone. Classroom instruction shall be carried out separately for different medium of instruction.

WRITTEN EXAMINATIONS

The first year written examinations will be conducted for six and a half theory courses by the University after the completion of 200 working days in the first year.

Each theory course question paper will be designed for 3 hours for full course and 1 ½ hours for half a course. The questions and allotment of marks are as described below:

(ii) When leave is applied for sickness, the production of a certificate by a Registered Medical Practitioner may be required.

3. (i) Students are not permitted to absent themselves from the college without applying leave.

(ii) In case where absence without leave is unavoidable applications for leave must be submitted as soon as possible and in no case later than the first day of return to the college.

(iii) Absence without leave for a part of the day and absence without leave for a full day will be counted as absence for one and two days respectively.

4. The necessary attendance certificate will not be granted unless the Principal is satisfied that the student's progress and conduct have been satisfactory.

5. Each candidate whose admission is approved by Tamil Nadu Teacher Education University should gain 85% (i.e., 170 days) of attendance, failing which they will not be permitted to appear for the B.Ed. degree examination. However, as per the decision of the Syndicate of Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University in its meeting held on 10.08.2010 candidates who are able to gain attendance only up to 75% on medical ground, will be permitted to appear for the examination after getting condonation of attendance, adhering to the norms of Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University.

In case of shortage of attendance, applications of condonation must be made to the University authorities and unless such condonation is obtained, students may not be able to sit for the examination.

❑ **Scholarship**

The District Adidravidar Welfare Department and the District Backward & Minority Welfare Officer offer residential Scholarship to students and Scholarship for ex-service personnel.

❑ **College Magazine**

Every year we bring out a College Magazine to promote creativity of our student-teacher and faculty.

❑ **Educational tours and visits**

The importance of educational tours and visits is being increasingly recognized. Whenever such excursions are organized by the college, it is obligatory on the part of the students to participate in such programmes and add to the richness of their training in the college. On all such occasions they should remember that they carry the fair name and traditions of the college with them.

❑ **Library**

There is a well equipped library and a department library for B.Ed. students.

All the students of the college are members of the library. Strict silence must be observed in the library. Every student will be supplied with 2 library tickets for borrowing books.

Students will be entitled to keep a book for 14 days from the date of issue.

If the book is not returned on or before the due date, an overdue charge of 50 paise will be levied for each day of delay after the due date including Sundays and holidays.

Periodicals, Dictionaries and Encyclopedias shall not be lent to students. Students are responsible for the books borrowed on tickets.

When the borrower's ticket is lost the matter should be immediately reported in writing to the Librarian, who will issue a duplicate on payment of Rs. 10-00 per ticket after a lapse of one month.

If a book borrowed is lost by the student he/she shall inform the Librarian in writing. He/she shall be required to replace the book. If the book is not purchasable in the market, he shall be required to pay the current cost of the book plus a processing charge at the rate of 25% of the cost of that book.

Hallticket for appearing for Examination will be issued only after the return of Library borrower's tickets to the Librarian.

Any infringement of rules will render the privilege of admission to and of borrowing of books from the library liable to forfeiture.

❑ **Hostel**

There are separate hostels for men and women and students can avail these hostel facilities.

The mess is run by the students themselves following Students' Parliamentary system. A mess deposit of Rs. 3000/- (refundable) is collected from each hostel student at the time of admission. The mess charges for every month should be paid before the 5th of the following month. The defaulters will be asked to vacate the hostel at once.
